Your student can choose between one or two semesters of clinical courses/lectures or 3-5 months of clinical clerkship. It is not possible to combine courses with clinical clerkship during the same academic year :

# Courses/lectures:

- <u>Courses/lectures</u> (module are in French). BMed3 of Bachelor, MMed1 and MMed2 years of Master are divided into thematic modules (5-6 weeks each). The learning agreement can combine courses/lectures of BMed3, MMed1 and MMed2 programmes as long as there is not too much overlap.
- Exams will be assessed at the end of each semester in January-February and April to July as defined in the study year.

The attendance at the exam sessions is mandatory for all the mobility students. ECTS credits are delivered according of the results of the exams and instructions/conditions for participating intum small group lessons.

# Clinical clerkships:

- On the learning agreement: Indicate the period of time during your student wishes to complete a clinical internship. Make 3-5 internship proposals over the desired period according to the internship <u>catalogue</u>. Student must comply with these rules:
  - The clinical clerkship starts on the 1st day of the month (even if this day is a Friday) and finishes on the 30th or 31st of the month.
  - The student is subject to the working conditions of the hospital / office in which he is practicing. There is no obligation to grant leave, this being the responsibility of the head of department and / or the administration of each hospital.
  - Students should introduce themselves to the department before (at least 24 hours) the first day
    of the clinical period to obtain informations about the internal organisation of the schedules of
    the department.
  - The students accept to be on duty during nights and weekends.
  - When the contract is signed, students can't modify it.
  - Language requirements level B2, certificate must be transmitted before the start of the internship. The clinical departmental may not accepted students if their performance in French does not meet this level.

Help to choose clinical clerkship on the online  $\underline{\text{catalogue}}$  - to look for internships available for exchange students:

- > Canton: Vaud
- > Discipline : choose the one that interests you (you can only choose clerkships in Lausanne!)
- > No stage : insert "vd" and "Rechercher"

**Language requirements**: linguistic abilities corresponding to the B2 level in French are required. Student must certify their language level by sending us the relevant certificate.

**Exams**: Attendance at the exams sessions are mandatory for each teaching

**Accommodation**: We cannot provide the student housing and accommodation. It is strongly recommended to look for and explore the possibilities as soon as possible. Useful information can be found at <u>find the accommodation</u> website of Social Affairs and Student Mobility Office.
