EDUCATIONAL CONTENT

Description

The Master of Law of the Universities of Zurich and Lausanne comprises 90 ECTS credits for a duration of 5 semesters at most. At least one semester is spent with each of the partner Faculties. The course is built as follows:

Common modules - 12 ECTS

- Zivilverfahrensrecht UZH (12)
- Civil procedure UNIL (6)
- Criminal procedure UNIL (6)
- Administrative procedure and jurisdiction UNIL (6)

Master thesis - 12/15 ECTS

Your choice of thesis topic must be validated by one of the two partner universities. It is awarded 12 ECTS credits at the University of Zurich and 15 ECTS credits at the University of Lausanne.

Compulsory free-choice module University of Zurich - 6 ECTS

Free-choice module University of Lausanne - 33/36 ECTS

33 ECTS if 15 ECTS credit dissertation validated in Lausanne / 36 ECTS if 12 ECTS credit dissertation validated in Zurich.
