



Registration as a doctoral student at the University of Geneva

If your lab is located in the University of Geneva or the HUG, you should enroll in our program through the University of Geneva.

This process must be done in two steps:

1. The Doctoral School Committee

Please send **one single e-mail** with the following documents to Sonia.Bolea@unil.ch, with copy to your thesis director:

1. Student's CV (two pages max).
2. Thesis title and brief description of the thesis project (one page max).
3. Letter from the thesis director accepting the student in his/her lab and engaging to support his/her salary for the duration of the thesis, and to provide the necessary equipment and materials required for the project.

This letter should also include the following information:

- Address of the laboratory where the project will be developed
 - Thesis co-director name (if needed)
4. Copy of your work contract.

2. Your Faculty.

Register as a PhD student in the **Faculty of Medicine, Sciences or FPSE**, whatever is closer to the domain of your previous training (even if your current lab is in a different faculty). You will be requested to provide originals of your MA diploma and copy of your passport, and to fill out different forms.

Please note that this will register you at the University of Geneva but it does not mean that you become part of the Doctoral School of that faculty. Your Doctoral School is the Lemanic Neuroscience one!

Both steps can be done **any time** during the year, but you can't start taking courses at the LN Doctoral School until you have sent your dossier to us.
