

Thesis committee composition for PhD students in the Cancer & Immunology thematic programme

IMPORTANT

- Thesis committee composition is selected by consent between the thesis director and the PhD student
- Experts should not have collaborated in the thesis project or published with the PhD student. For the final exams, at least one of the experts has to be from outside UNIL/CHUV. Note that you can add or pick other experts for the final exams
- When selecting members of your thesis committee/jury, please make them aware that they have to be present in person at the mid-thesis exam and private exam. In principle, remote participation by videoconference will not be allowed. NB: the qualifying exam, specific to the Cancer & Immunology thematic program requires the presence of the President (PhD Programme representative), the thesis director and the Expert A.
