



Yiannos is a lawyer at the European Commission. He works in the DG for Internal Market, Industry, Entrepreneurship and SMEs (DG GROW). He is in the team dealing with the application of Arts. 34-36 TFEU (free movement of goods). The work of the team mainly focusses on infringement actions against Member States (Arts. 258 and 260 TFEU); preliminary rulings before the Court of Justice of the EU (Art. 267 TFEU) and examining the compatibility of national legislative proposals notified to the European Commission under Directive 2015/1535.

Prior to joining the European Commission, Yiannos was a lecturer in EU law at the Law Schools of the Universities of Edinburgh and Dundee. He holds a Ph.D. in EU law from the University of Edinburgh and was a post-doctoral research fellow at the Institute for Advanced Studies in the Humanities (IASH), University of Edinburgh.
