



**9<sup>th</sup> EuTEACH Summer School  
First Advanced Course  
Lausanne, July 3-8 2011**

**Report submitted by JC Surís  
August 2011**

The 9<sup>th</sup> EuTEACH Summer School took place in Lausanne from July 3<sup>rd</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> and, for the first time, was an Advanced Course. The objective of the course was:

***To improve the capacities of learners  
to teach and promote adolescent health in their countries***

### **The participants**

We had 26 participants from 15 countries (Armenia; Belgium; Bosnia; Denmark; Finland; Germany; Greece; Israel; Malaysia; Moldova; Nigeria; Sweden; Switzerland; United Kingdom; United States of America) and with diverse backgrounds, although the vast majority were physicians (10 pediatricians; 4 GP & 2 MD in community health; 2 Social workers; 2 OBGYN; 2 Nurses; 2 Teachers; 1 Anthropologist & 1 Physiotherapist). Almost half of all participants (12/26) had participated in the Basic Course.

Overall participants enjoyed the course and their evaluations (see below) were very positive.
