

Pro-Femmes Grants

Eligibility criteria at the time of submission

The candidate must have a doctorate in medicine or science; a current or planned activity within the CHUV, UNIL or Unisanté and an academic career plan; the grants support women (all people self identifying as such) who have **already initiated an autonomous project** and need help to advance their academic career.

Evaluation of applications

Applications are evaluated by the Equal Opportunities, Diversity and Integration Commission. The following will be taken into consideration in the evaluation of applications:

- the scientific quality of the project
- the project presentation and feasibility
- the impact and productivity of the applicant and the degree of autonomy in their research
- the impact of the fellowship on the pursuit of an academic career and the coherence of the budget.
