## **Call for Papers**

As in previous years, the SEM offers PhD and advanced MA students the opportunity to present their research to their peers and to a group of scholars working in the field of medieval English studies. We invite papers of *c.* 5000-8000 words on any topic related to the English Middle Ages. All papers will be forwarded to all participants to be read before the conference and will be presented individually by senior scholars who will briefly summarise them and prepare critical questions and feedback for the plenary discussion. This procedure has proven very fruitful in previous years and has significantly contributed to the general discussions of the papers as well as to the friendly atmosphere, in which emerging scholars can test the waters of academia and establish networks with other medievalists.

Abstracts should be sent to <a href="kathrin.reist@ens.unibe.ch">kathrin.reist@ens.unibe.ch</a> by 7 December 2012, and the final papers by 8 February 2013. We would be grateful if a number of senior scholars were to volunteer to introduce, and comment on, a student paper.
