

Application of hygiene measures by students

1. Students are encouraged to download the SwissCOVID application

2. Participation in lessons is regulated in a way that promotes social distancing, thereby reducing both the risk of transmission of the SARS-CoV2 virus and the extent of quarantine following the occurrence of cases of COVID-19.
3. Students must respect the attendance regulation instructions transmitted by the UNIL and the faculties.
4. Students are required to wear a mask for all movement within campus buildings. They should stock up accordingly.
5. As a reminder, wearing a mask is mandatory on public transport.
6. Students respect a distance of 1.5m from each other in the line of access to the auditoriums and classrooms, as well as when leaving these premises.
7. Students use the hydro-alcoholic solution to disinfect their hands at the entrance to the building and then at the entrance to the teaching room.
8. Wearing the mask in auditoriums and classrooms :
 - In classrooms where it is easy to count the number of people present: The persons present may remove their masks once seated if i) their number is less than or equal to the capacity allowing the respect of a distance of 1.5m, displayed at the entrance, and ii) if only the places indicated to respect this distance are occupied. In other cases, the persons present keep their masks on during the teaching.
 - In the classrooms: Those present keep their masks on during the teaching. During the semester, once the number of participants in each course has stabilized, courses compatible with a distance of 1.5m between participants will be identified and their participants will be informed.
9. In situations where it is prescribed, the mask must be handled according to recommendations.
10. Individuals with symptoms suggestive of COVID-19 should immediately abstain from participating in the teachings in the presence of others. They must submit to Coronacheck and, if necessary, contact a physician or health care center.
11. If such symptoms occur during a day on campus, the person concerned must return home with a mask, submit to Coronacheck and, if necessary, contact a doctor or health care center.
12. Persons who have stayed in countries with a high risk of infection according to the FOPH must have complied with a 10-day quarantine period before they can attend the courses.
13. Note on vulnerable persons: the recommendations of the Federal Office of Public Health applicable in the context of the teachings are the same as for the general population. These people are invited to observe them very rigorously.
14. If students have a problem that compromises the application of hygiene measures (e.g. due to a disability), they are asked to contact their faculty or school so that measures adapted to their situation can be taken.
