SAMEMES Book Prize
Regulations
(revised 26.5.2017)

1. SAMEMES invites SAMEMES early career members to submit their first published monograph, written in English, for the SAMEMES Book Prize.
2. The monograph is in the area of medieval and/or early modern English studies.
3. A monograph can be submitted only once.
4. Submission in the form of one hard copy and a pdf file should be sent to the SAMEMES president. The submission deadline should coincide with the submission deadline for abstracts for the biennial conference.
5. The prize is awarded every second year, on the occasion of the SAMEMES Conference.
6. A panel made up of three board members, or exceptionally two board members and another SAMEMES member, is responsible for recommending to the SAMEMES board one of the submitted monographs for the prize.
7. The panel may decide not to recommend a prize.
8. The prize, of the value of SFr. 1000.-, is offered on the occasion of the SAMEMES Conference, with a laudatio offered by one of the panel members.
9. In exceptional circumstances, more than one prize can be awarded, in which case the prize money may be split between two or more candidates.
