400'000 deaths/year

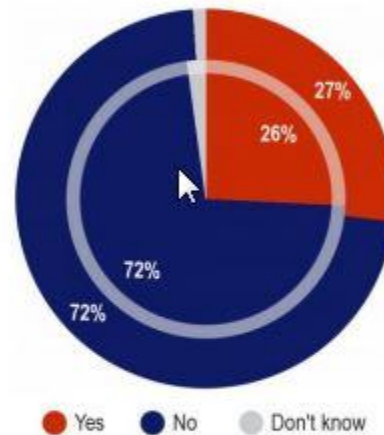

Outer pie : EB80.2 Nov.-Dec. 2013

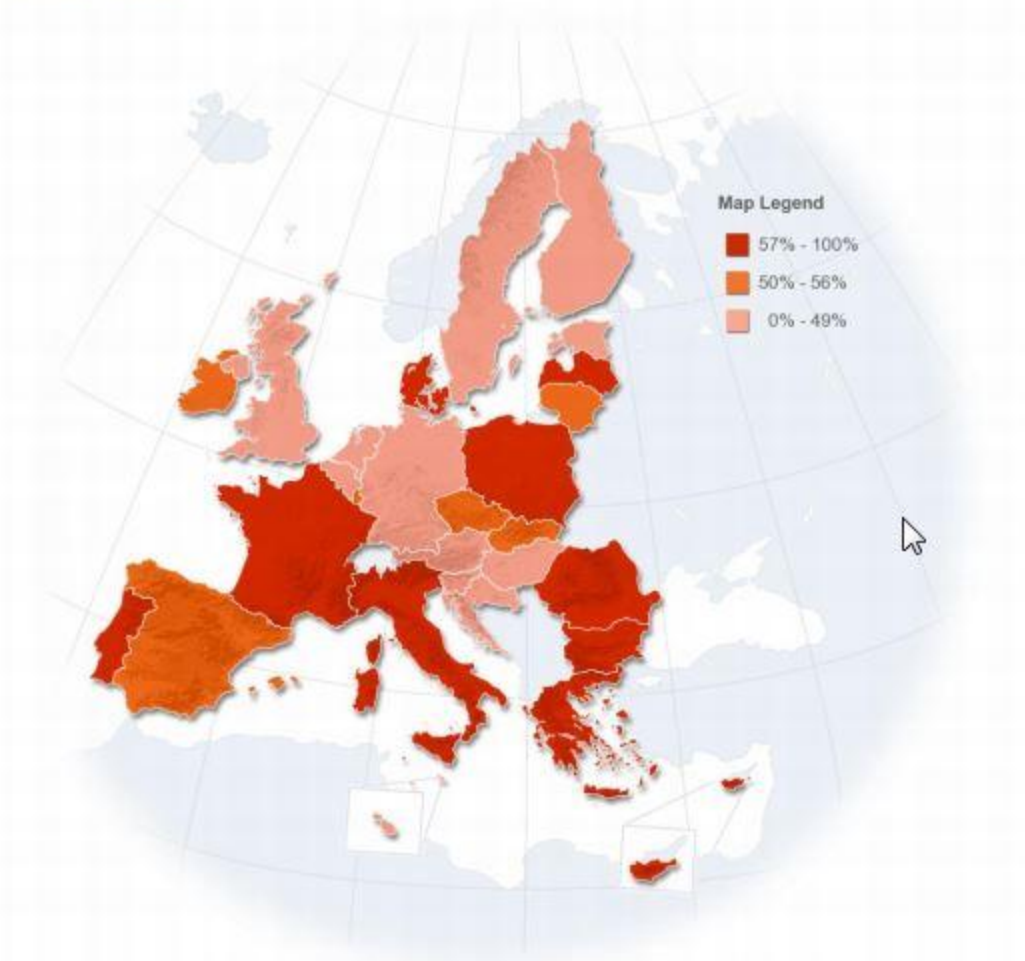

Answers: Total 'Likely'

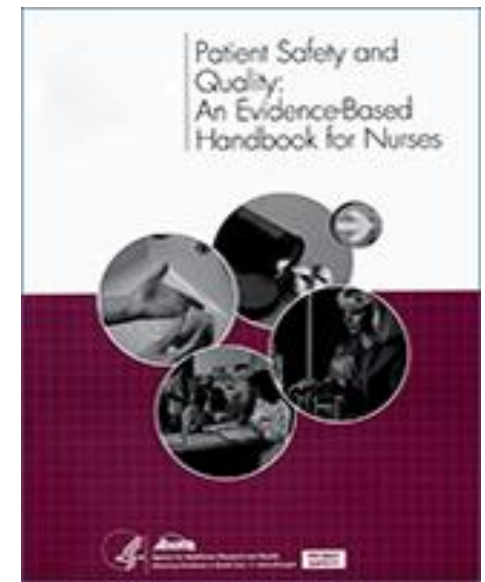


How are we doing in

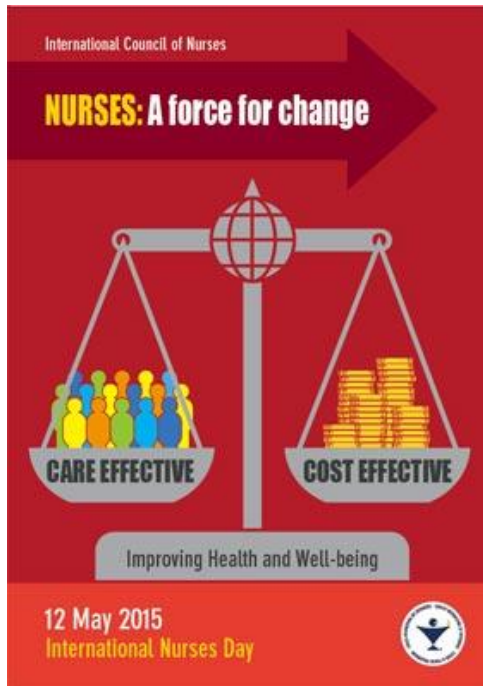
- 11% of Swiss citizens reported a medical error in their care in the last two years, with **poor coordination of care** being a particular problem.
- 30% of physicians and 16% of nurses reported at least one patient safety incidents
- occurred either daily or weekly

Nurses: Key players

- patient safety and practices that prevent harm have focused on negative outcomes of care, such as mortality and morbidity.
- Nurses are key players in reducing adverse outcomes.
- Impact of nursing care on **positive quality indicators**, such as appropriate self-care and other measures of improved health status.
